**ALL STOCK IS BEING DONATED to this Series.** **Huge** Thank you to Steele Productions for the steers and calves, and to Donita Duvall for the goats. With the generosity of the Stock donations, we are able to offer payouts at each of the Series Rodeo dates. Percentage of payouts will be determined by amount of sponsorships received to cover prizes/expenses. For the 2026 Series, we will be starting with a 90% payout due to the Spring Creek Association decreasing our Grant that has been used towards the venue fees.

**Entries due by deadlines:** Indicated on the top of all entry forms.

**There is a *mailed by date*, and an *eMailed by date*.** Please pay attention to dates. **Entries can be mailed or eMailed.** \$10 late fee if received after deadline.

The rodeos are a series of four (4) that will be ran with points (10 pt system) to be accumulated towards year end awards.

**\*\*\*Contestant must compete in at least (3) of the scheduled events to be eligible for Year-end prizes.\*\*\***

**\*\*Events ran together (boys & girls) Jr. Calf Riding, Jr. & Sr. Team Roping, & Sr. Steer Riding.**

**\*\*All-around boys and girls awards in each age group will be given at year end. Age groups will be: 6 & under, 7-10, and 11-14 (no High School). In the event of a tie, *ties will be broken by best total times/scores.***

**Sr. Steer Riding - \*\*Girls will only be able to ride for prizes. No AA Points\*\***

**Jr. Boys – \*\*Choice of Figure 8 OR Steer Stopping – Cannot enter in both\*\***

**Team Roping Jrs. & Srs.**

**\*\*Open Event\*\* One contestant and a partner of their choice (must be an adult unless approved in advance). Only contestant pays entry fee.**

**“Entering Up” – Contestant can enter up in an event for PRIZES ONLY. No AA Points earned.**

**Entries should only be sent to Carrie. If you have questions, please call or text her at (775)304-2223.**

Any changes to entries must go through Carrie: call, or email her at cnjeary@yahoo.com. Day Sheets will be posted before the Rodeo. If you make any changes, or did not get your entry in on time your entry may not reflect on the day sheet. Please call to confirm entry at this point. **You will be allowed to pre OR post ride for (1) rodeo (exceptions need to be approved). You will pre ride for a rodeo directly before the missed rodeo. You will post ride for a rodeo directly after the missed rodeo. Emergency situations may be considered.**

**WE NEED HELP IN THE ARENA!!! Our events will run quicker, and smoother with HELP, so parents, we are asking for you to be a part of this Series and STEP UP/STEP IN where needed!!! 😊**

## 2026 Ruby Mtn Jr. Rodeo Series Rules

Spring Creek Horse Palace (Spring Creek, NV)

6pm Sharp Start Time

- WESTERN ATTIRE MUST BE WORN DURING ALL ARENA EVENTS BY ALL CONTESTANTS, CONTESTANT HELPERS, AND PARTICIPATING ADULTS IN THE ARENA.
- ADULT ASSISTANCE BEYOND ANY STARTING LINE WILL RESULT IN A 30 SECOND PENALTY *(except stated below for peewees)*
- ALL DECISIONS MADE BY THE ARENA DIRECTORS WILL BE FINAL.
- THE DIRECTORS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO DISQUALIFY THE CONTESTANT FOR PARENT INTERFERENCE OR DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR.

**Goat Undecorating:** Time starts when contestant crosses the start line. They must pull ribbon from the goat's tail. Time stops when contestant runs back across start/finish line with at least a piece of the ribbon. Parents/helpers stay behind the start line.

**Dummy Roping:** 3 loops. Each loop will be timed, and all 3 will be added together for a final total. Time starts when roper enters box, time stops when slack is pulled tight. Roper must stay in box while roping. If roper steps out of box while roping, it will result in a 5 second penalty.

**Team Roping:** No tie ons, 3 loops, 3 legal head catches, 60 second time limit. Must rope with an adult unless approved by directors.

**Breakaway Roping:** String will be furnished. 2 ropes = 2 loops / 1 rope = 1 loop. Rope must be tied on. If roping calves, then catch-as-catch-can after rope passes over the calves' nose. Rope must have a flag attached to the tail. 30 second time limit.

**Steer Stopping (Boys):** Rubber on horn is permitted. 2 loops allowed. 30 second time limit. 3 legal head catches. Must face once steer is roped in order for the time to stop. 10 second penalty for broken barrier.

**Goat Tying:** Jr High & High School Rodeo rules apply. 60 second time limit. Goat must be daylighted, but 3 feet is NOT necessary. **Sr Boys must use a piggin string.**

**Flag Race:** Barrel 1 and 2 of pattern will be used. There will be a bucket on each barrel. Contestant starts with flag in hand (either L or R side start is ok), deposits flag in first bucket, retrieves flag from second bucket, and crosses finish line. Must keep moving in continuous forward motion. 30 second time limit. Knocking over barrel or bucket is NT. Dropped flag (outside of bucket) is NT. Whipping horse with the flag is a NT.

**Calf Riding & Steer Riding:** Must ride for 6 seconds to receive a score. Calf riders can ride with 2 hands, but will score better using one.

**Barrel Racing:** High School Rodeo rules apply.

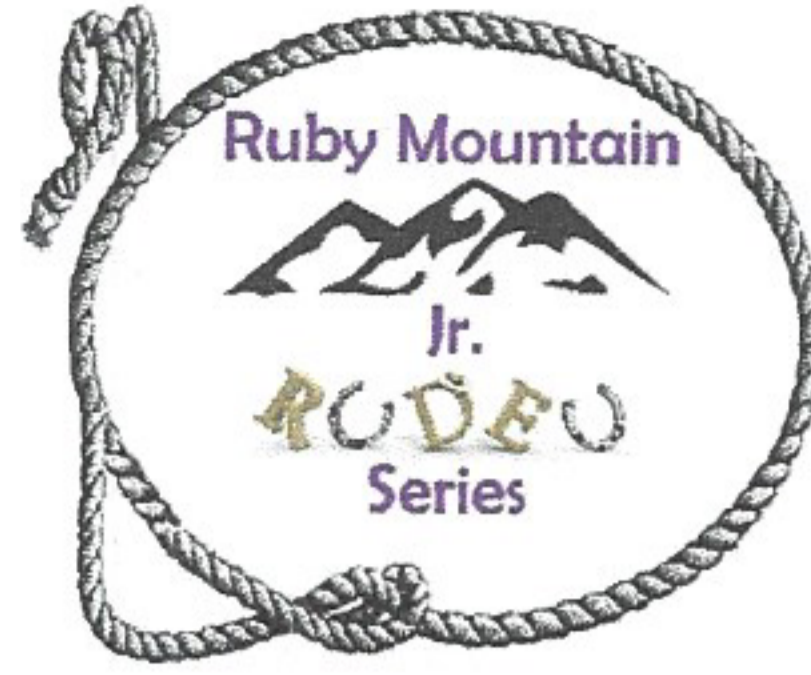
**Pole Bending:** High School Rodeo rules apply.

**Figure 8:** Time starts and stops at start line (electric eye will be used). Patterns will be posted, and available at check in.

**PeeWee Barrels, Poles, & Figure 8 will use a "Step System" for placing ----**

**example: no assistance (parent stays behind start line), "no hands on" assistance (parent leads, but with no lead rope), "hands on" assistance (parent leads with a lead rope)**

**\*\*Please remember that if you are leading your child, you must be in Western attire, and you must cross the start/finish line at same time as we are using an electric eye.\*\***

Responsible Adult Sponsor means any person over the age of 18, parent, or legal guardian, who sponsors any contestant in any RMJR event.

**1. AGREEMENT OF CONTESTANT AND RESPONSIBLE ADULT SPONSOR:** In consideration for the contestant's participation in any RMJR event, in any location, and at any arena, the contestant, whose current name and address appears below, and the responsible adult sponsor, hereby agrees as follows:

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** Contestant and responsible adult sponsor hereby acknowledge that participation in any RMJR event, either as a contestant, observer, member of RMJR, helper, or volunteer, is an inherently dangerous activity and could expose the contestant and responsible adult sponsor to a substantial and serious risk of physical harm or injury, property damage, or death. The contestant and responsible adult sponsor hereby acknowledge that by participating in any RMJR event, they are assuming the risk of any property damage, physical harm or injury, or death, whether or not caused by the negligence or gross negligence of any RMJR member, agent, and/or representative or any arena owner or property owner where any RMJR event is held.

**3. RELEASE OF RMJR AND ITS SPONSORS:** Contestant and responsible adult sponsor hereby release RMJR and its sponsors from all liability, property damage, injuries, or any other claim arising from or caused by the participation of contestant or responsible adult sponsor in any RMJR event, whether or not such claim or cause of action is known, unknown, or unforeseen.

**4. COVENANT NOT TO SUE:** Contestant and responsible adult sponsor hereby agree that they shall not now, or at any time in the future, directly or indirectly, commence or prosecute, or cause to be commenced or prosecuted, any action, suit or other legal proceeding, against RMJR, its agents, members, and/or representatives, any person or organization sponsoring any RMJR event, any sponsors agents, members, and/or representatives, or any other person or organization upon whose land is held any RMJR event. **5. ASSURANCES:** Contestant and responsible adult official hereby agree and acknowledge that they possess full power, authority, capacity, and right, and/or have been given and provided with full power,

authority, capacity, and right, to enter into, execute, deliver, and perform this Participant Release Form. Contestant and responsible adult sponsor further acknowledge and assert that their execution of this Participant Release Form is done voluntary, without coercion, and that they are of sound mind, and have read, and understood all aspects of the Participant Release Form.

6. BINDING EFFECT, CONFLICT OF LAWS, AND SEVERABILITY This Participant Release Form, including all of its provisions, singularly, and collectively, shall be binding upon the contestant, the responsible adult sponsor, the contestant's and the responsible adult sponsor's spouse, parent and/or legal guardian, legal representative(s), heirs, successors, and assigns. 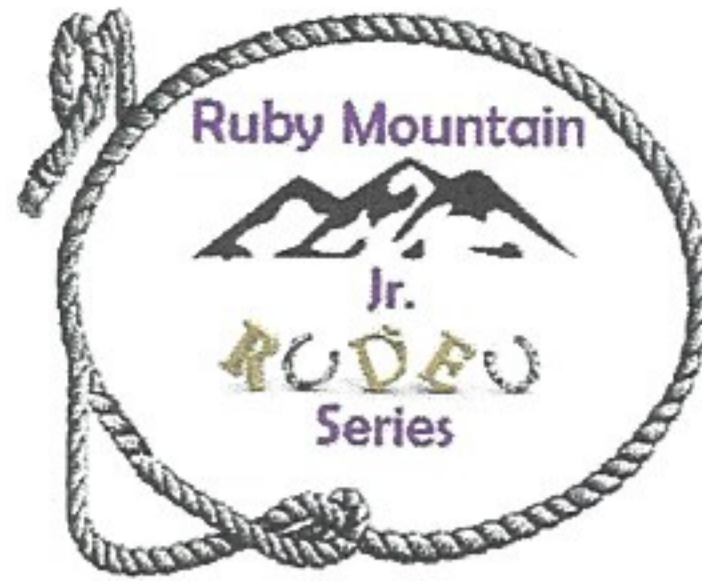
